Instruction for Abstract Submission

- **Word Limit:** The abstract should be between 250-300 words, summarizing the main theme and key points.
- **Format:** Submit the abstract in Microsoft Word format (.doc or .docx) with a standard font size (12-point, Times New Roman). **Or** Hindi font mangal (font size 14 points) with 1.5-line spacing and clearly state the research objective
- **Title:** The title of the abstract should be concise and reflect the content, not exceeding 15 words.
- **Author Information:** Include the name, affiliation, and email address of the author(s). If there are multiple authors, indicate the presenting author.
- **Keywords:** Provide 3-5 keywords that best describe the topic and content of the abstract.
- **Language:** All abstracts must be written in English & Hindi ensuring proper grammar and clarity.
- **Submission Deadline:** Abstracts must be submitted by the specified deadline; late submissions may not be considered.
- **Plagiarism:** Ensure the abstract is original and free from plagiarism.
- **Presentation Format:** Indicate whether the abstract is intended for an oral or poster presentation.

Instruction for paper submission

- **Format and Length:** Papers should be submitted in Microsoft Word format (.doc or .docx), with a maximum length of 2000-3000 words, including references, tables, and figures. Use 12-point Times New Roman font, with double-spacing. For Hindi mangal/ Kurti dev 10
- **Structure:** The paper should include an abstract, introduction, methodology, results, discussion, conclusion, and references. Follow the specified citation style (e.g., APA, MLA).
- **Submission Deadline:** Submit the full paper by the specified deadline. Late submissions may not be accepted or considered for review.
